REGISTRATION

Register for camp online. Online registration is not available for those who receive financial aid, please contact the camp admin to register.

ENROLLMENT FORMS

Caregivers will provide the program with child's enrollment forms through our UpBup platform, including documentation of child's annual physical examination and most recent immunizations. In addition, the YMCA must be provided any medications (including inhalers and EpiPens) required during program hours in the original box and prescription label if applicable, a Medication Consent form, and an Individualized Health Care Plan signed by the child's doctor or other licensed health care provider.
